If you are 25 or under you can achieve an Arts Award.

The award has 5 levels: Discover, Explore, Bronze, Silver and Gold.

Arts Award assesses your creative, communication and leadership skills.

Why should I do an Arts Award?



Arts Award is an opportunity to achieve a qualification while you:

have fun learning new things

work with arts professionals

share your skills with other people

You can get creative in any art form, become a critic, lead your own project and find out about arts careers.

What can I explore?








discover different artforms






